

# Uniform Policy

At St Augustine's, we believe that wearing a uniform helps to create a sense of belonging, pride, and equality among our pupils. We ask that all children wear the correct school uniform every day and that it is kept clean, tidy, and in good condition.

## Winter Uniform (September to Easter)

- Green school jumper or cardigan
- White collared shirt
- School tie
- Grey trousers
- Tartan pinafore or skirt
- Dark green / grey tights or socks
- Black school shoes (no trainers)



## Summer (Easter to the end of the school year in July)

- Lemon gingham summer dress
- Green school jumper or cardigan
- Grey tailored shorts
- White polo shirt
- No tie



### Additional Guidance

Jumpers and cardigans should be plain green or carry the school logo.

Shirts must be tucked in and ties worn neatly.

Skirts and pinafores should be an appropriate length for school.

Jewellery should be kept to a minimum (e.g., small stud earrings only).

Hair should be neat and tied back if long with black bobbles (bows must be small green)

### PE (Physical Education) Uniform

On PE days, pupils should come to school dressed in their PE kit.

PE Kit:

- Yellow t-shirt
- Black sports shorts or long cycling shorts
- Trainers suitable for sports activities
- Green jogging bottoms (for colder weather)
- School jumper or PE hoodie



### Additional Guidance

- PE kit should be clearly named and kept clean.
- For safety reasons, jewellery and watches must be removed during PE.

**All items of clothing and footwear must be clearly labelled with your child's name.**
